State Rules Interpretation Meeting Reminder

The State Rules Interpretation Meeting will be made available beginning **Wednesday October 12, 2022.** This meeting will be completed online and accessed through your individual myOHSAA account.

If you are a new coach, please consult your athletics director to assist with getting your account set up in myOHSAA. Confirmation of completing this meeting is required. Failure to complete this meeting prior to **Monday November 28, 2022, at 11:59pm** will result in a late fee.

Swimming and Diving National Governing Body Non-Interscholastic Waiver – NEW SUBMISSION PROCESS

Per GSR 7.7.2, a non-interscholastic waiver may be provided for student-athlete(s) to compete in events sponsored by a National Governing Body. Swimming and diving student-athletes that qualify for any of the following events may receive a waiver.

Junior Nationals
Senior Nationals
US Open
Pro Series Meets
Mid-State Championship (Middle School Only)

This is a one (1) time waiver for the 2022-23 OHSAA Swimming and Diving season. The form can be accessed HERE.

7th and 8th Grade Change in Sport Season Waiver

Per GSR 32.2, schools, leagues or conferences may adjust seasons to accommodate school teams because of the lack of availability of physical facilities or personnel or due to other reasons as deemed appropriate by the league or conference. Proposed changes in seasons shall be submitted in writing to the Executive Director and include the proposed dates of the 7th & 8th grade season not to exceed the length of the interscholastic season for the sport concerned. All other regulations regarding contest limitations, required practice time and coaching requirements shall be followed.
