The OHSAA State Swimming and Diving Tournament tickets will be conducted online through HomeTown Ticketing. There will be no physical tickets sold at the gate. A QR code will be provided for fans to purchase an electronic ticket at the venue. Tickets are general admission and may be purchased [HERE](#).

Spectators may begin lining up 90 minutes prior to the doors opening for the event.

- *Para qualifiers will be included in the ticket distribution for the DII Finals.
- *Public purchase tickets are available from the time noted until the end of the event.
- *Times are subject to change.

Ticket Purchasing Procedures:

All ticket communication to administrators will be provided from Claudia Markoff, OHSAA Customer Experience Manager (cmarkoff@ohsaa.org). It is the responsibility of the athletic director to distribute tickets to his or her coaches and parents for purchase.

Division I and II State Diving Sessions: General admission tickets will be available online for purchase beginning Monday February 19 at 10:00AM. Specified ticket allotments will not be distributed to qualifiers and coaches for pre-purchase. Those planning to attend diving sessions are directed to purchase tickets online through the OHSAA website on a first come first serve basis until the sessions are sold out.

Division I and II Swimming State Qualifiers and Coaches – PRELIMS: Qualifiers and coaches shall receive a specific number of tickets in advance to purchase. Ticket allotments shall be determined by the number of qualifiers advancing to the state tournament.

Athletic Directors shall receive these codes via email on Sunday February 18th and will be responsible for distributing ticket purchasing codes to each coach and qualifier. Those with codes may purchase tickets beginning Monday February 19th at 10:00AM and will have until Wednesday February 21st at 12:00PM to purchase tickets before they are released for public purchase.

Division I and II Swimming State Qualifiers and Coaches – FINALS: Finalists and coaches qualifying for the final rounds of the state tournament shall receive the same number of tickets allotted for the prelims in advance to purchase. Para qualifiers will be included in the DII Final ticket distribution.

Athletic Directors shall receive these codes via email soon after the conclusion of the prelims and will be responsible for distributing ticket purchasing codes to each coach and qualifier. (See chart for deadlines to purchase)

Once the tickets are distributed, qualifiers and coaches will have up until a specific deadline to purchase tickets before they are released for public purchase. Deadlines will be included with the advanced purchase information. Please note, due to the schedule of events, this will be a quick turnaround. **The codes provided for the finals will be different than those provided to the preliminary rounds.**

State Relay Alternate(s): Per the OHSAA Tournament Regulations, only teams that qualified for relays shall be provided the opportunity to purchase a maximum of two (2) relay alternate passes for \$25.00 each. Deck space is limited, and coaches are encouraged to only purchase passes if necessary. **Alternate passes must be purchased on site with credit card only. Cash or checks will not be accepted.**

College Scouts: A small allotment of tickets will be available for college scouts with a valid ID to purchase on site the day of the event. Tickets are based on availability and will be on a first come first serve basis. Those wishing to purchase tickets must enter through Door N1.
