Monday February 23 through Friday February 27: During school hours, the staff parking lot is not available for fans. Fans will go to STATE SWIM MEET PARKING in the Unity lot/Student lot for free parking on first-come first-serve basis. Additionally, there are paid lots available for a \$10-\$15 fee.

Saturday February 28 and after school hours during the week: All school lots are available for free parking. Overflow will be paid lots for \$10-\$15 fee.

Additional notes:

- ADA Parking: Parking is available first-come first-serve
- School Buses (team or students): Buses will park in the Stadium Park Tennis Court Lots located off of Fulton Avenue and Stadium Park Drive. There is also limited parking along the fence on Helen Avenue behind the youth fields. Buses should not be parked in any of the parking lots located on the Natatorium Campus.
- Light blue parking lot is reserved for OHSAA staff and officials (parking pass required) from Feb. 23-28.
- Cash and credit card accepted.
- Prices and available lots subject to change.

TICKETS:

- Tickets may be purchased in advance through the OHSAA website [HERE](#).
 - Student: \$15.00
 - Adult: \$20.00
- A QR code will be available to scan to purchase tickets on-site. Highly encourage advance purchase as the event sells out regularly.
- Tickets for this event are general admission.
 - ADA seating is available. Please see a staff member for assistance with finding seating locations.
- Stands will not be cleared between diving sessions, but WILL be cleared between swimming sessions.
- **NO RE-ENTRY IS PERMITTED INTO THE VENUE.**

ENTRY AND CREDENTIALS:

The main entrance (Door 1N) will open to spectators beginning 90 minutes prior to the start of the event. Fans may begin lining up outside 90 minutes prior to the doors opening for spectators. Digital Tickets and working credentials are required for entry.

Teams and student-athletes may enter Door 2N or 5N.

Fans are expected to follow all the instructions of venue security and event staff. Failure to adhere to all policies may result in loss of ticket privileges and ejection from the venue.

PROHIBITED ITEMS:

NO blankets.

NO bells, sirens, horns, or other artificial noisemakers.

NO paper like materials of shakers/pompoms/confetti-party poppers.

NO paper like materials of signs, banners.

NO coolers.

NO balloons.

NO glass containers.

NO tripods are allowed (handheld video recorders only).

NO camp chairs or basic stadium chairs (no bigger than 17" including armrest).

NO umbrellas.

NO large bags. NEW – maximum of 12x12 for bags! PLEASE NOTE!

NO speakers.

ADDITIONAL NOTES:

- Appropriate banners must be tied, not attached to any surface – not flags or signs.
- **Spectators are NOT permitted on the deck at any time.**
- Empty clear plastic water bottles will be allowed, but no outside drinks or food are permitted.

BAG POLICY:

Bags are subject to search upon entry. Approved medical/diaper bags are permitted and will be searched. Larger bags must be returned to vehicles. **Size limit – 12x12 – NEW, PLEASE NOTE!**

FAN AMENITIES:

- Concessions: **No outside food or beverage is permitted.** Guests may purchase food and beverage on the bridgeway located behind the spectator seating.
- Restrooms: Family, men's and women's restrooms are available on the main level
- Programs: A tournament program will be sold on site for purchase. The cost will be \$5.00 via credit card only.
- Heat Sheets: Final heat sheets will be available for purchase for \$3.00 (cash only).
