Steps To Finding Officials

- Start Now!
- Don't just send an invitation via Dragonfly, reach out to officials directly via email or phone.
- Connect with, build a relationship with, and work with your local officials associations to help fill your spots. Local association secretaries are a good first contact.
- Identify volunteers who can become officials, helping fill your needs as well as the needs of the sport in general.
- High school students can become Class Three officials and work the 7th and 8th grade meets.

Non-Officials Mandatory Training

Any non-official working in an officiating capacity (For example parents helping mark/measure/record at field events, volunteers working as umpires for relays, etc.) **MUST** complete the free NFHS *Introductory to Track Officiating* course at the following link: https://nfhslearn.com/courses/officiating-track-and-field. They will need to set up a free account and "order" the self-paced course.

This course is also STRONGLY recommended for all volunteers working any meet especially events at the HS district level also.
