REGIONAL TOURNAMENT INFORMATION

MEETING FOR REGIONAL QUALIFIERS

Schools qualifying for the Regional Tournament will be contacted by their Regional Tournament manager prior to the Regional Tournament. Regional Tournament managers may host meetings (virtual or in-person) and schedule times to be available for questions. The Regional Manager is required to arrange for all collection of materials electronically and provide necessary information to all participating schools.

ADMISSION

The admission fee for Regional Tournaments will be \$5.00 for students and \$12.00 for adults. One ticket may permit admission to both Semifinal matches on the same evening. TEAM AND SCHOOL PERSONNEL

Fifteen players and seven others, a total of 22 persons, will be admitted at the Regional site's pass gate via Team Bench List. This list will be used at the pass gate for all sessions of the Regional Tournament—see more under "Documents" below.

Each participating school shall continue to receive 8 complimentary school administrator tickets for the Regional Tournament. School administrators shall use the same coded tickets from Hometown Ticketing that they have been using throughout the postseason tournament.

CHEERLEADERS

Six cheerleaders in uniform, or five cheerleaders and a mascot, and one sponsor, will be provided complimentary admission at the pass gate provided the certified Cheerleader Pass List is filed by the high school Principal—see more under "Documents" below.

WARM-UP PERIOD

There will be a 30-minute warm-up on the court by both teams. Teams shall be provided 10 minutes of ball handling after the coin toss takes place. After the 10 minutes of ball handling, the 20-minute warm-up shall be broken down into the following designated times, in order, and shall start immediately the 10 minutes of ball handling, as well as immediately after the first match concludes:

1. 2 minutes – both teams ball handling on their side of the net
2. 6 minutes – the serving team has the whole court
3. 6 minutes – the receiving team has the whole court
4. 3 minutes – the serving team has the whole court
5. 3 minutes – the receiving team has the whole court

NOTE: There may be no use of volleyballs in the facility while team is not on the court for the designated time. This includes all areas of the facility – auxiliary gyms, hallways, etc.

SCOREKEEPER

A courtesy scorekeeper from each participating school is requested at the scorer's table.

BANDS

No bands are permitted.
