Re: December Update

1 – State Individual Wrestling Ticket Order Forms

The State Individual Wrestling Tournament ticket order forms were mailed to each wrestling school on November 27.

As in past years, each school is entitled to receive:

1 – yellow form (for coaching staff and school administrators) – opportunity to purchase up to eight (8) lower bowl, all-session tickets for \$75 each

1 – blue form (for school group / boosters) – opportunity to purchase an unlimited amount in the upper bowl, all-session tickets for \$55 each.

If you have not received the forms by end of business today (December 11), please email me and I will place replacement forms in the mail. Please be sure to double check with your AD and school's central office for the forms before contacting me for replacements.

2 – Weight Assessments and Appeal Period

Take the time right now to inspect each of your wrestler's weight loss plans in Trackwrestling. Remember, you can only appeal a wrestler's assessment in the 14-day appeal period. The 14-day appeal period begins the day after the initial assessment. Once the 14-day appeal period has passed no appeal assessments are able to be conducted. Appeal assessments do not appeal the weight recorded in the initial assessment, only the skinfold measurements. If the appeal is valid, the wrestler's weight loss plan will use the weight and date of the appeal assessment for the wrestler's new weight loss plan.

4 – Sites for the Regional Round of OHSAA Dual Team Wrestling Tournament

Below is the list of sites that will be used for the regional round of the OHSA Dual Team Wrestling Tournament on Saturday, February 8, 2020.

A few reminders on regional site assigning:

1 –The site assignments have nothing to do with your athletic district, which is used for the individual tournament.

2 – Your region (both by site and number) from last year are completely irrelevant for the purposes of this year's assigning.

3 – The sites create their own geographical cluster of teams. Just because you are geographically closer to one site (or was assigned there last year) does not mean that you will be assigned to that site in 2020.

4 – The teams assigned to each site will change each year due to site changes, division changes, and changes in participating schools.

The deadline to enter or withdraw from the dual team tournament is January 13, 2020. Sites assignments will be announced no later than Wednesday, January 22, 2020.
