1 - Update on State Tournament

Also, please note the schedule for admitting coaches into the state tournament based on the number of qualifiers in <u>each session</u>:

- 1 qualifier 2 coaches
- 2 4 qualifiers 3 coaches
- 5 9 qualifiers 4 coaches
- 10 14 qualifiers 5 coaches

2 - Wrestlers Making Scratch Weight at Sectional

I get this question often this week each year, "Can one of my wrestlers make scratch weight at sectionals?"

The answer is YES. A wrestler is permitted to make scratch weight at a weight class for the first time at sectional weigh-ins.

3 - Practice Arrangements After Sectional

As stated in wrestling regulation 1.41:

After the conclusion of the Sectional Wrestling Tournament, wrestlers who qualify for further competition may "practice" with wrestlers from other schools who are similarly qualified.

Beginning next week, your remaining wrestlers are permitted to practice with wrestlers from other schools. These practice arrangements do <u>not</u> need to be reported to me in writing, as they would normally during the regular season.

4 - NFHS Rules Questionnaire for Next Season

Each year the NFHS distributes a questionnaire nationwide to all states to gather information on the application of new rule changes, but also to gauge the wrestling community's interest in potential rule changes for future seasons. Ohio has consistently ranked among the highest response rates each year, and I am proud of our community's engagement in this process. 5 - Minimum Weight for the 285-Pound Weight Class

The minimum weight for the 285 lbs. weight class in Ohio is 215, which increases to 217 after the December 25th 2 lbs. growth allowance is granted. This regulation is codified in the wrestling regulations under Section 1.72.
