### 2020-21 Season Award Winners (Presented in March 2022)

#### 2021 Division I Coach of the Year



**Todd Haverdill – Brecksville-Broadview Heights**

Coach Haverdill is finishing his 23rd year of Coaching and his 21st year as head coach at Brecksville-Broadview Heights High School. Over the course of those 21 years, Coach Haverdill has led his teams to 10 consecutive State Top 5 team finishes. Coach Haverdill's 2021 team had a school record 11 state qualifiers and finished as the state runner-up at both the State Duals and the individual tournament. His teams have finished in the top two in the state six times, including the 2015 Team State Championship.

Under his leadership, the Bees have been recognized for 10 consecutive years in the National team rankings, including being ranked as high as the number 3 high school wrestling team in the nation during the 2020 COVID shortened season.

Prior to this year, Coach Haverdill has coached 112 State Qualifiers, 69 State Placers, and 9 State Champions. He would like to congratulate the other division coaches on their awards, and thank all his Coaches, wrestlers, and parents past and present for their involvement.

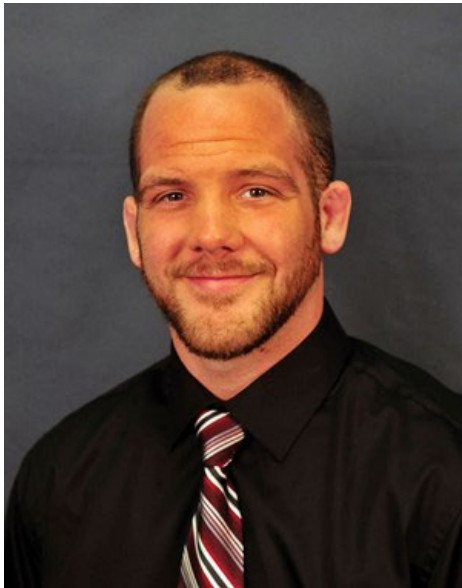

### 2021 Division II Coach of the Year



**Travis McIntosh – St. Paris Graham**

Travis was born and raised in Jamestown, Ohio. He attended Miami Trace High School where he was a State Champ in 2011 and a runner-up in 2010. After high school he went to college and wrestled at Campbellsville University in Kentucky where he was a two-time national qualifier and an NAIA National Finalist in 2015.

After college, Travis moved to St. Paris, Ohio, where he worked for the Jordan Wrestling Camp and started his coaching career under one of the greatest wrestling minds the sport has to offer, Jeff Jordan. As an assistant coach he was a part of the 2016, 2017 and 2018 traditional and dual team state titles. Coach Jordan retired in 2018 and as

the head coach Travis was able to continue the tradition of winning dual and traditional team state titles in 2019 and 2021.

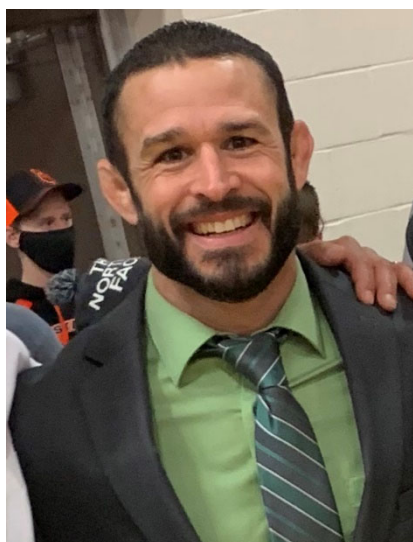

### 2021 Division III Coach of the Year



#### **Anthony Carizales – Delta**

Anthony began wrestling in the Delta Wrestling Club (DWC) in 1st grade and continued wrestling in his hometown of Delta through High School. His varsity head coach was OHSWCA Hall of Fame member Robin Rayfield. While in high school from 1996-1999 Anthony contributed to a state runner-up team finish and three team state titles. His senior season Delta was ranked in the top 15 in the country. As an individual he placed 4th, 2nd, 2nd and 1st at the State tournament.

In college Anthony wrestled at Ohio University for Joel Greenlee from 2000-2004. He was part of Ohio University's 2001 Mid-American Conference championship team. As a four-year starter he placed 3rd, 2nd, 2nd, and 3rd individually at the MAC tournament, and was a two-time NCAA tournament qualifier.

Coach Carrizales began his coaching career as an assistant at Delta before going to Whitmer High school for two seasons under head coach Tom Bridges. He moved back to Delta as an assistant under Jeff Wolford before becoming head coach for the 2011 season. In his 10 seasons as head coach, Delta won the OHSAA State duals four years in a row from 2013-16. At the individual state tournament, Delta's teams placed 3rd twice, runner-up twice and won team championships in the 2014 and 2016 seasons. Anthony is proud to have led his individual wrestlers to 61 State qualifications, 43 State placements, and 12 individual State championships.

Coach Carrizales gives thanks to Jesus Christ for all his success in the sport of wrestling. Since stepping down as head coach at the end of last season, Anthony has enjoyed taking a more active role in his church and spending more time with his wife Megan and children Gabriella, Troy, Sidney and Leah.

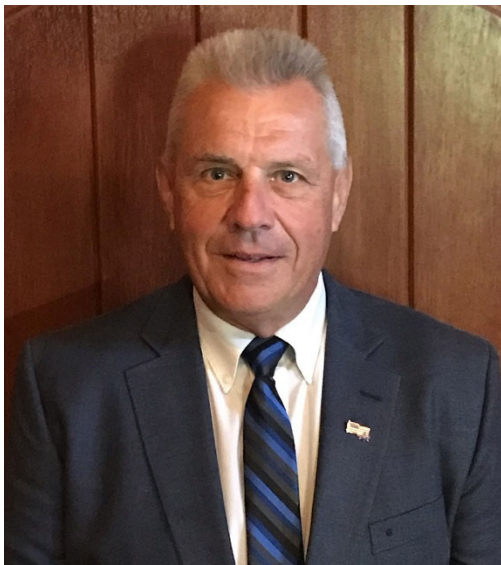

**Zach Ison, Batavia, Cincinnati Archbishop Moeller and

Zach is a 1976 graduate of Clermont Northeastern High School. Zach was a member of both the wrestling and football teams (1973-1976). Zach is a graduate of Wilmington College (1982) and was a teacher at Clermont Northeastern from 1984-2011. During his years of teaching, Zach was the head coach at Batavia High School, assistant coach at both Clermont Northeastern and Cincinnati Archbishop Moeller. Zach has been active with USA Wrestling and Team Ohio Wrestling, serving as an assistant coach, head Greco leader, and Greco Director.

Zach was team leader of the Cadet Pan Am Team 2017 and Junior Greco Pan Am Head Coach in 2019. Zach has served as past Vice President of SWOWCA and a director of SWOWCA wrestling tournament.

### **2022 OHSAA Service Award Winner – Tommie Goff**



Tommie was originally from Copley, Ohio where he wrestled in high school and was nicknamed “The Cradle King.” In 2001, Tommie started coaching the Brooke Cub Pee Wee Program and became the head coach a year later. Then in 2007, he moved to a private club with fellow coach/best friend and called it the Valley Venom Vipers, or “Team Vipers”. They used a sweaty cramped room which was a one-and-a-half car garage. In 2008, he started the Viper Pit Tournament in a small gym and later it turned into a National Tournament in 2016. Tommie also

introduced girls wrestling into the Viper Pit in 2015 and it has grown larger and larger every year.

In 2009-2012, Tommie started helping at Harding Middle School. Then moved up to varsity coaching at Steubenville from 2012-16. Tommie also had a stint at Weir High School in Weirton, WV. In 2018, he opened his own club called GT Wrestling and was back helping at Harding Middle. In 2020, was hired to start the first female wrestling team at Steubenville High School and first in the area.

Tommie tragically passed away on December 5, 2020, before the team could start their season. Tommie made sure no child ever went without food or wrestling gear. His wrestlers were a part of his family. Tommie always believed his wrestlers needed to have mental toughness and heart. Those two things make a good wrestler. Tommie would jump in any wrestler’s corner to coach no matter what team colors a kid wore, because we were all family.

Excepting this award is Tommie’s wife Janel and two Daughter’s Gabriella and Ciara. Tommie was highly respected among his fellow coaches, his wrestlers, their parents and all of the wrestling community.

## Jack Regis

In 1992 my officiating career started at a Martins Ferry High School open tournament. I stopped to watch Larry Deaton and a few other officials on my way to see my brother. Larry and Steve Kish were working short because of a no show official. They told me to get on a mat and help. So that's when the fire started to become an official.

From there I went on to get my officials license and with the help of many experienced officials I've had a very good career officiating. Some of my officiating includes:

I have worked the tables at both the State tournament and the State individual tournament for many years and I enjoy each and every time I'm involved. 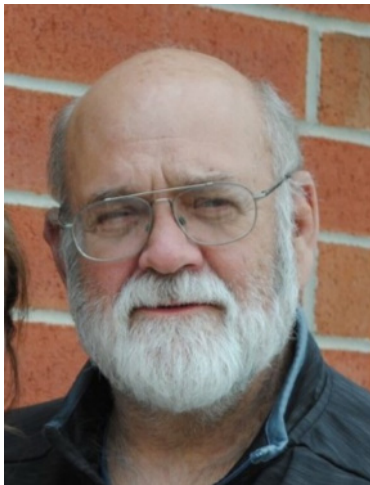
# OWOA 50 Year Awards

## 2020 Media Service Award Recipient



### Chris Easterling - Massillon Independent

Chris Easterling's career covering wrestling for the Massillon Independent started randomly enough, with a season preview being thrown at him last minute in 1999. That was introduction to a sport which he never participated in growing up, yet has become one of his favorites to cover.

This marks his 20th consecutive state wrestling tournament. In the two-plus decades he's been covering the sport, he's been fortunate to document 40 individual state champions, more than 100 state placers and innumerable individuals simply achieving a life-long goal of reaching the state tournament.

Chris began his career in 1994 as a correspondent for The Independent while still a senior at Canal Fulton Northwest High School. After attending the University of Kentucky, Chris began working full-time for the paper in 1998. Through his sports writing career, he has covered University of Kentucky football and basketball, the Cleveland Indians, multiple NCAA basketball tournaments, the last two NCAA Wrestling Championships, along with hundreds of high school games.

He would like to thank all of the Stark County coaches and wrestlers over the years who have been of great assistance to him, including but certainly not limited to Dave Riggs, Dan Michel, Dan Staats, Mike Mattingly, Chase Horvath, Dave Tolarchyk, Brent McBurney and Nate Carr. He would also like to thank all of his media brethren, specifically Josh Lowe, whose encyclopedic knowledge of the sport is always seemingly accessible.

He would also like to thank his family for their support, even his younger brother J.R., who is the former head wrestling coach at Akron Manchester High School and currently is a OHSAA wrestling official.

Finally, and most importantly, he would like to thank his daughter Brianna, an eighth-grade student at Northwest Middle School in their hometown of Canal Fulton.

# High School Wrestling Tied to Professional Wrestling?

In 1920, Ohio State University appointed Al Haft Head wrestling coach, the second year Ohio State had a wrestling team. As an army hand-to-hand combat instructor during World War I, Al taught thousands of young soldiers wrestling moves that could save their lives. One of his early wrestling recruits was Harry Steele, a farm kid from East Sparta, Ohio. Harry became an NCAA champion and was the Gold Medalist in the 1924 Olympics. He was the last wrestling gold medalist from Ohio State until Kyle Snyder in 2016.

The depression hit a few years later and collegiate and interscholastic wrestling was put on the back burner. In 1947 Casey Fredericks, a 1932 National Champion from Purdue and a professional wrestler, was named as the new Head coach at Ohio State. He too had been a hand to hand combat drill instructor. At the time, millions of soldiers were returning home to start families, and there was considerable interest in wrestling.

During this time, Al had owned several gyms around Columbus and had become a professional wrestling and boxing promoter. Haft had brought greats to Columbus: Joe Louis, Jack Dempsey, Jim Corbette, Jess Williard, Gene Tunney... WRESTLING, Farmer Burns, Ed "Strangler" Lewis, Joe Stecher, Zbyszko brothers, John Pesek, Mildred Burke, Gorgeous George, and Nature Boy Buddy Rogers. He and Casey knew that in order for both High School and Professional wrestling to grow, the fan base need to be extended with young athletes introduced to the sport. They went on the road, traveling throughout Ohio, putting on demonstrations, talking to local Boards of Education, Athletic booster clubs, Kiwanis, Rotary clubs, anyone who would listen. By 1957, the number of High schools with wrestling programs grew from 14, to 257.

Both Al and Casey had an interesting group of people they recruited to help. Al employed his brother in law, George Woodland, to referee both professional boxing and wrestling. Bob's son, Don Woodland, was given the task to start a new program at Pleasantview, one of the first central Ohio Schools to have wrestling outside of Worthington and Arlington. When Franklin Heights was built, Don and his assistant coach, Bob Mowery started wrestling there. Don moved on to become the head coach at Capital University, and later became a state senator and liquor commissioner. Don also helped start the program at Ready High School where his son Eric was a two time state champion. If you have ever stopped in at a Donerick Lounge in Columbus or Dublin, they were started by Don and Eric.

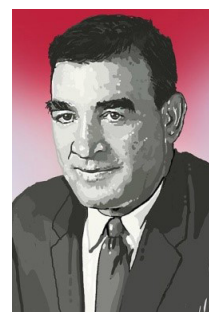
As the sport expanded, the practice of having the coaches referee the matches became problematic. Casey talked his long time assistant coach at Ohio State, Tony Montonaro, into writing the rules and mechanics for officials. Tony traveled the state with his notebooks and assisted groups in organizing and training officials. With the backing of the Ohio High School Athletic Association, Tony tried to bring consistency throughout the state by setting up a series of local associations. In 1965, there were still no written rules for the conduct of matches, and the NCAA and National Federation of High Schools invited Tony to a meeting in Chicago to develop the rules book. Tony's notebook was the basis of the first official book published in 1966.

Bob Mowery became the first president of the Central District Wrestling Officials Association and also served as its secretary. Casey Fredericks and Al Haft were inducted into the Ohio Wrestling Hall of Fame in 1970, Tony Montonaro in 1971, and Don Woodland in 1978. Bob Mowery was inducted into the Ohio Wrestling Officials Hall of Fame in 1995.

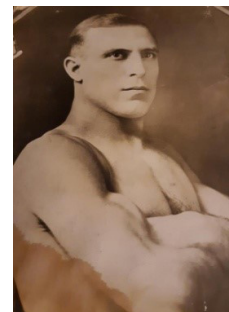

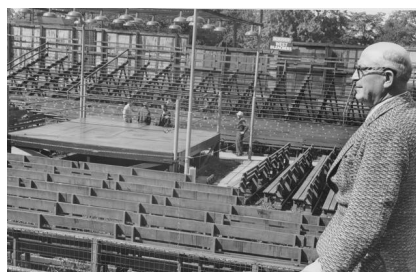
