# A Guide To The Matches



## How to Follow OHSAA State Wrestling Tournament Matches

A Matchboard is used to schedule all matches. It is located above the center scoreboard. In addition, TV monitors located in the Concourse hallways and the Auxiliary Gymnasium can be viewed by wrestlers, coaches, and spectators. The Matchboard will indicate the following: Wrestling; On Deck (wrestlers positioned behind the respective mat); Bullpen (wrestlers should report to the Bullpen); Warm Up (wrestlers will be moving to the Bullpen in approximately 8-10 minutes). Check the Matchboard and/or TV monitors occasionally to know the current status of your match. Note: A number outlined in Red is a Medical Default; a number outlined in yellow is a Forfeit; a number outlined in green has a 1X or 2X State Champion competing; while a number outlined in blue has a 3X State Champion competing.

All wrestlers and coaches must report to the Bullpen and check in with the "Ushers." The Matchboard screen will look like this:

Memorize the match numbers found in this program for the wrestlers you are following. The Match Number is the key (see pages 14-16).

Most matches have been pre-assigned to a specific mat. Look through this program for your matches. Some matches have been marked T.B.A., "To Be Assigned." These matches will be assigned over the Public Address System and Matchboard to mats that finish early.

Championship matches are six minutes long, divided into three equal periods. Consolation matches shall consist of three periods also; the first will be one minute in length, and the second and third periods each two minutes in length. The first period of each match starts from a standing position. Second and third periods begin with the wrestler that has the choice selecting up, down or the neutral position.

When the contestants are tied at the end of the three regular periods, they will wrestle overtime. Overtime will consist of a one-minute sudden victory period, and if needed two 30-second tiebreakers. Scoring in the two tiebreakers will be conducted as in a regular match. If the score remains tied at the conclusion of the two 30-second tiebreakers, a 30-second ultimate tiebreaker shall take place with the first person scoring declared the winner. If no scoring occurs during the ultimate tiebreaker, the offensive wrestler will be declared the winner and one match point shall be added to the offensive wrestler's score.

Wrestlers earn points during matches by — Takedown: 2 points Reversal: 2 points Escape: 1 point Near Fall: 2 or 3 points

### Tournament Policies

1. Pairings Criteria: The random pairings for the OHSAA State Wrestling Tournament are conducted prior to the start of the District Boys and Regional Girls Tournaments and are based on the following criteria: A. Each District Boys and Regional Girls has representation in each quarter bracket with an equitable balance of all pairings by district and regional— 1 vs. 4 & 2 vs. 3; B. No 2 wrestlers from the same district and regional will meet in the 1st round; C. Pairings are balanced; D. Returning OHSAA State Placers who finished either 1st, 2nd, or 3rd the previous year will be separated in accordance with their previous place provided they qualify for the State Tournament as a Boys District or Girls Regional Champion; E. If Returning State Placers are from the same district or regional, the wrestler(s) only loss must be to a top 3 state placer from the previous year.
2. Alternate – Boys District or Girls Regional 5th Placer: Prior to the completion of the Friday Weigh in, if one qualifying wrestler is unable to wrestle, the 5th place wrestler from that district or regional shall be placed on the vacated bracket line in the 1st round. No other wrestler will be moved on the bracket. This procedure will take place at the weigh in site.
3. Alternate – Other Boys Districts or Girls Regionals 5th Placers: If the 5th place wrestler from the district or regional with the vacated spot is unable to wrestle, 5th place alternates from the remaining 3 districts or regionals become eligible for the vacated bracket line. If only 1 alternate is able to wrestle, he/she is placed on the bracket line. Otherwise, a coin flip (2 alternates) or random draw (3 alternates) determines which alternate will be placed. No other wrestler is moved on the bracket. This procedure will take place at the weigh in site.
4. Alternates – Multiple From Same Boys District or Girls Regional: 2 wrestlers are unable to wrestle then A. If 2 alternates are present then a coin will be flipped. The winner will be placed on the lowest numbered open bracket line; the loser will be placed on the other open bracket line; B. If 3 alternates are present then a random draw will be conducted. The first name drawn will be placed on the lowest numbered open bracket line. Then a second name will be drawn for the other open line. Note: Bracket lines are numbered 1 – 16 (NFHS Rules Book, 10 – 4). No other wrestler is moved on the bracket. This procedure will take place at the weigh in site.
5. No Alternates: A Bye is placed on the bracket for a wrestler who is unable to wrestle and no alternate is available.
6. DQ & Forfeit: After the scheduled start of Session 1 when a wrestler wins by: A. DQ (When an opponent is removed from participation in accordance with the NFHS Rules Book Penalty Chart); or B. Forfeit (When an opponent fails to appear for a match), the winning wrestler must report to the mat to claim the win.
7. Medical Default: After the scheduled start of Session 1 when a wrestler wins by Medical Default (When an opponent is unable to continue wrestling), the winning wrestler does NOT have to report to the mat to claim the win.
8. Failure to Make Weight: A wrestler who fails to make weight each day of a tournament is ineligible for further competition and cannot place in the tournament unless failure to make weight is due to injury or illness. The wrestler does not receive an individual award nor be on the awards stand. He/she loses placement points for the team, but retains all team points earned earlier.
9. Session Start Time: Any session scheduled starting time could be altered due to weather or any other unforeseen circumstance.

### Advancement Points

1. When a wrestler wins a match, he/she scores 2 points for a championship bracket match and one point for a consolation bracket match. There are no advancement points awarded for the final championship and consolation matches.
2. When a wrestler wins by a fall, he/she scores 2 additional points; when he/she wins by technical fall (15 pts.), he/she scores 1.5 additional points; and when he/she wins a major decision by 8 to 14 points, he/she is awarded 1 point.

### Placement Points

If a wrestler places in the tournament, he/she scores points in this manner:

### Professionalism of Coaches

It is the moral obligation of all Ohio Wrestling Coaches to conduct themselves in a manner that reflects credit upon their high school, their profession and themselves. Personal grooming and appropriate dress is a standard of professionalism. The wearing of jeans, shorts, t-shirts, sweatsuits and warm-up suits (top or bottom), head wear and similar apparel are not considered suitable attire for coaches during the OHSAA State Wrestling Tournament and, therefore, are prohibited. Coaches who are inappropriately dressed will not be allowed on the arena floor. Moral obligation and ethical conduct are part of winning and losing. Good sportsmanship, appearance, pride, honor and concern for the well-being of the competitors should be placed before all else. The Rules have been established in the spirit of this statement.

# Ohio High School Wrestling Coaches Association 2024 Hall of Fame Inductees



**John Groff**  
Malvern and Sandy Valley

John served as the Head Wrestling Coach for 3 years at Malvern High School and then 36 years at Sandy Valley. In his 39 year tenure John finished with a career record of 397 wins, 174 losses and 3 ties, placing him 9th on the OHSAA History Book. This led to 16 conference championships, 9 sectional titles, and 2 Ohio Duals participations. John also coached 42 state qualifiers, 9 state placers and 3 state runner-ups.

**Jeff Kullman**  
Minerva



Jeff is a graduate of Massillon Perry High School and Ashland University, started his coaching career in 1985. After serving as an assistant coach for 2 years at Massillon Perry and 3 years at Minerva High School, Jeff served as the head coach of Minerva High School for 22 seasons from 1991-2013. During that time, he has helped coach 46 state qualifiers, 21 state placers and 5 state champions. As head coach, his teams have placed in the Top Ten at the District Tournament 8 times and have had 4 Top 20 finishes at the State Tournament. He has been named Stark County Coach of the Year twice, and is also a member of both the Minerva and Stark County Wrestling Hall of Fames. Beyond his "official" retirement from Minerva, Jeff also served 2-years as an assistant coach for The University of Mount Union, where they placed 5th in the nation in 2019; and is now assisting his son, Micah Kullman, head coach at Louisville High School. Alongside his high school coaching career, Jeff has played a vital role in the development of both freestyle and Greco-Roman wrestling in the state with his involvement in USA Wrestling-Ohio. Over his 30-year span of involvement with USA Wrestling-Ohio, Jeff has served 3 years as a head freestyle coach; 15 years as the 16U age-group director; and the last 6 years as USA Wrestling-Ohio's National Team Director for all men's and women's teams. In 2011, Jeff was awarded The USA Wrestling National Coaches Education Program Instructor of the Year.

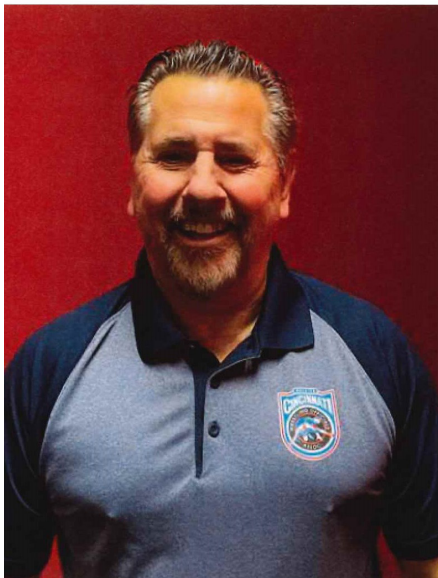
# Ohio Wrestling Officials Association Hall of Fame



Rick began his 45-year career in the field of wrestling in 1978, coaching at Eastmoor High School for 12 years, and then moved on to Brookhaven High School in 1990. He built well-respected programs at both schools, amassing an overall record of 147-74, winning 5 Columbus City League titles, and coaching 37 League Champions, 31 District Qualifiers and 6 State Qualifiers. Rick worked to develop outstanding athletes, his teams always being well-prepared to compete at the highest levels.

Rick is in his 26<sup>th</sup> year as a member of the Central District Official Association. He served as Secretary of the Central District Wrestling Officials Association for 10 years, and was an assigner, primarily for the Columbus City League and the Central Catholic League, for 15 years. He was awarded Rookie of the Year in 2005 and Central District Official of the Year in 2008. Rick worked 19 Sectional Tournaments, 18 District Tournaments and a State Tournament in 2008. He is currently a weigh-master and team captain for timers and scorers for the OHSAA State Wrestling Tournament, a position he has held for the past 17 years. In addition, Rick was the Tournament Director for Columbus City Schools for several years and has worked 5 Division II College Regionals as a timer and scorer.

Rick retired in 2019 after 40 years in education. He served his last 20 years as Director of Guidance at St. Francis DeSales High School. Rick has been married to his wife, Jane, for 52 years. He has 2 daughters and 4 grandchildren. Next to his family, Rick is most proud of his accomplishments as an educator, a wrestling coach and official.
