

# A Guide To The Matches



## How to Follow OHSAA State Wrestling Tournament Matches

A Matchboard is used to schedule all matches. It is located above the center scoreboard. In addition, TV monitors located in the Concourse hallways and the Auxiliary Gymnasium can be viewed by wrestlers, coaches, and spectators. The Matchboard will indicate the following: Wrestling; On Deck (wrestlers positioned behind the respective mat); Bullpen (wrestlers should report to the Bullpen); Warm Up (wrestlers will be moving to the Bullpen in approximately 8-10 minutes). Check the Matchboard and/or TV monitors occasionally to know the current status of your match. Note: A number outlined in Red is a Medical Default; a number outlined in yellow is a Forfeit; a number outlined in green has a 1X or 2X State Champion competing; while a number outlined in blue has a 3X State Champion competing.

All wrestlers and coaches must report to the Bullpen and check in with the "Ushers." The Matchboard screen will look like this:

Memorize the match numbers found in this program for the wrestlers you are following. The Match Number is the key (see pages 14-16).

Most matches have been pre-assigned to a specific mat. Look through this program for your matches. Some matches have been marked T.B.A., "To Be Assigned." These matches will be assigned over the Public Address System and Matchboard to mats that finish early.

Championship matches are six minutes long, divided into three equal periods. Consolation matches shall consist of three periods also; the first will be one minute in length, and the second and third periods each two minutes in length. The first period of each match starts from a standing position. Second and third periods begin with the wrestler that has the choice selecting up, down or the neutral position.

When the contestants are tied at the end of the three regular periods, they will wrestle overtime. Overtime will consist of a one-minute sudden victory period, and if needed two 30-second tiebreakers. Scoring in the two tiebreakers will be conducted as in a regular match. If the score remains tied at the conclusion of the two 30-second tiebreakers, a 30-second ultimate tiebreaker shall take place with the first person scoring declared the winner. If no scoring occurs during the ultimate tiebreaker, the offensive wrestler will be declared the winner and one match point shall be added to the offensive wrestler's score.

Wrestlers earn points during matches by — Takedown: 3 points Reversal: 2 points Escape: 1 point Near Fall: 2, 3, or 4 points

### Tournament Policies

1. Pairings Criteria: The random pairings for the OHSAA State Wrestling Tournament are conducted prior to the start of the District Tournaments and are based on the following criteria: A. Each District has representation in each quarter bracket with an equitable balance of all pairings by district – 1 vs. 4 & 2 vs. 3; B. No two (2) wrestlers from the same district will meet in the 1st round; C. Pairings are balanced; D. Returning OHSAA State Placers who finished either 1st, 2nd, or 3rd the previous year will be separated in accordance with their previous place provided they qualify for the State Tournament as a District Champion; E. If Returning State Placers are from the same district, the wrestler(s) only loss must be to a top 3 state placer from the previous year.
2. Alternate – District 5th Placer: Prior to the completion of the Friday Weigh in, if one qualifying wrestler is unable to wrestle, the 5th place wrestler from that district shall be placed on the vacated bracket line in the 1st round. No other wrestler will be moved on the bracket. This procedure will take place at the weigh in site.
3. Alternate – Other District 5th Placers: If the 5th place wrestler from the district with the vacated spot is unable to wrestle, 5th place alternates from the remaining 3 districts become eligible for the vacated bracket line. If only 1 alternate is able to wrestle, he/she is placed on the bracket line. Otherwise, a coin flip (2 alternates) or random draw (3 alternates) determines which alternate will be placed. No other wrestler is moved on the bracket. This procedure will take place at the weigh in site.
4. Alternates – Multiple from the Same District: 2 wrestlers are unable to wrestle then A. If 2 alternates are present then a coin will be flipped. The winner will be placed on the lowest numbered open bracket line; the loser will be placed on the other open bracket line; B. If 3 alternates are present then a random draw will be conducted. The first name drawn will be placed on the lowest numbered open bracket line. Then a second name will be drawn for the other open line. Note: Bracket lines are numbered 1 – 16 (NFHS Rules Book, 10 – 4). No other wrestler is moved on the bracket. This procedure will take place at the weigh in site.
5. No Alternates: A Bye is placed on the bracket for a wrestler who is unable to wrestle and no alternate is available.
6. DQ & Forfeit: After the scheduled start of Session 1 when a wrestler wins by: A. DQ (When an opponent is removed from participation in accordance with the NFHS Rules Book Penalty Chart); or B. Forfeit (When an opponent fails to appear for a match), the winning wrestler must report to the mat to claim the win.
7. Medical Forfeit: After the scheduled start of Session 1 when a wrestler wins by Medical Forfeit (When an opponent is unable to continue wrestling), the winning wrestler does NOT have to report to the mat to claim the win.
8. Failure to Make Weight: A wrestler who fails to make weight each day of a tournament is ineligible for further competition and cannot place in the tournament unless failure to make weight is due to injury or illness. The wrestler does not receive an individual award nor be on the awards stand. He/she loses placement points for the team, but retains all team points earned earlier.
9. Session Start Time: Any session scheduled starting time could be altered due to weather or any other unforeseen circumstance.

### Advancement Points

1. When a wrestler wins a match, he/she scores 2 points for a championship bracket match and one point for a consolation bracket match. There are no advancement points awarded for the final championship and consolation matches.
2. When a wrestler wins by a fall, he/she scores 2 additional points; when he/she wins by technical fall (15 pts.), he/she scores 1.5 additional points; and when he/she wins a major decision by 8 to 14 points, he/she is awarded 1 point.

### Placement Points

If a wrestler places in the tournament, he/she scores points in this manner:

### Professionalism of Coaches

It is the moral obligation of all Ohio Wrestling Coaches to conduct themselves in a manner that reflects credit upon their high school, their profession and themselves. Personal grooming and appropriate dress is a standard of professionalism. The wearing of jeans, shorts, t-shirts, sweatsuits and warm-up suits (top or bottom), head wear and similar apparel are not considered suitable attire for coaches during the OHSAA State Wrestling Tournament and, therefore, are prohibited. Coaches who are inappropriately dressed will not be allowed on the arena floor. Moral obligation and ethical conduct are part of winning and losing. Good sportsmanship, appearance, pride, honor and concern for the well-being of the competitors should be placed before all else. The Rules have been established in the spirit of this statement.

Match Numbers are assigned to a specific Mat Number or "To Be Assigned" (TBA). Use this table to determine approximately what time a match will be wrestled. Each championship match takes approximately 9-10 minutes. Each consolation match takes approximately 8-9 minutes.

### Steven Asmus



Conrad began his sports journalism career at the Ashland Times-Gazette in 1996 and covered his first state tournament in 1997. He spent four years at the Times-Gazette, covering the state tournament each year, before taking a job at the Mansfield News Journal.

While at the News Journal, Conrad worked alongside 2015 Media Service Award recipient Jon Spencer.

Conrad left the News Journal for Richland Source in 2013 and has covered the state tournament every year since. Richland Source is a locally-owned, independent online news organization headquartered in Mansfield and has expanded its footprint into Ashland, Knox and Delaware Counties.

Conrad has won more than 50 state and national awards for his reporting. He was selected the Ohio Prep Sports Media Association Sports Writer of the Year in 2022 and was runner-up for the award last year.

Conrad would like to thank the north central Ohio wrestling fraternity for its support and cooperation over the years. He considers it a privilege to cover the sport for the area's knowledgeable fan base.

Conrad and his wife, Cheryl, live in Mansfield. They will celebrate their 22nd wedding anniversary in June. Their son, Cruz, is a freshman majoring in biological sciences at Ohio University.

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Since 1995, a media member has been honored at the OHSAA State Wrestling Tournaments for his or her outstanding dedication and service in covering the sport of interscholastic wrestling. The honoree will also be presented a plaque in ceremonies prior to the third session on Friday evening. For the first two years of the award, the honoree was selected by state tournament management. Beginning at the 1996 state tournament, a system was established whereby media members covering the state finals select the winner for the following year. The previous winners have been:

## Girls Coach of the Year Ben Kirian - Findlay

Coach Ben Kirian has enjoyed 26 years of wrestling coaching. 21 years boys only and the last 5 coaching both boys and girls teams. The son of a wrestling coach who has now coached for over 50 years it feels like he has always been around the mat. He credits this relationship that his Dad Dean has with the sport for why he has such a love for wrestling. His coaching Philosophy states "As an interscholastic wrestling coach, I believe my mission is to develop student-athletes who grow not only as competitors but as confident, capable, and compassionate individuals. Wrestling serves as the conduit through which athletes learn lessons that extend far beyond the mat, they prepare them for success in life."

Over the course of the last 5 years of coaching girls. Coach Kirian has fully committed to it and seen the same commitment come from his athletes. He started the largest and most competitive girls tournament in the state bringing in girls from all over the region as well as some from across the country. This year's event had over 600 girls participate.

The Trojans 2024-2025 girls team had 8 Top 5 Tournament finishes including a Sectional Championship and finishing 4th in the state tournament. Through the first 4 years of the program the Findlay girls team has produced 18 District/Regional Placers, 7 State Placers, 2 Champions, the 2025 Outstanding Girls Wrestler for the state tournament, 2 Fargo All-Americans, 6 girls currently wrestling in college and 1 NCAA National Qualifier in 2025.

In addition to coaching the Trojan Girls, Coach Kirian has also been honored to be a member of the Ohio Girls National Duals team staff for the last three seasons and is the current OHSWCA President. Outside of wrestling he is also a Social Studies Teacher and Department Chair, Strength Coach, Lacrosse Coach, and Union Negotiator.

Coach Kirian is supported by his wife Beth and their three sons Cole, Lincoln and Mason. He credits their support with his ability to find joy and success in coaching.

This is given to former wrestlers who are highly successful in other walks of life and use the disciplines learned in wrestling in their profession.

## Medal of Courage

A former wrestler who has overcome what appear to be insurmountable challenges, which may be physical, mental, or other disabilities that make their achievements all the more uplifting.
