2021 Coaches Sportsmanship Award Recipient

Each year, all 26 of the Ohio High School Athletic Association sanctioned sports' coaches associations and the four allied professional organizations can recognize and honor one of their members with an OHSAA Sportsmanship, Ethics and Integrity (SEI) Award. The recipients are selected by the directors or executive committees of the respective coaches or allied organizations.

Individuals selected should reflect the values of sportsmanship, ethics and integrity in all their professional responsibilities.

This Ohio High School Wrestling Coaches Association has selected **Upper Arlington head coach Matt Stout** as its 2020-21 SEI Award recipient. He will be honored at this weekend's state tournament.

Stout began coaching in 1995 and has served the past ten years as head coach at his alma mater, Upper Arlington High School. During his tenure as head coach at Upper Arlington, Stout has coached 18 state qualifiers and four state placers while mentoring over 350 student-athletes. His teams have captured three Sectional championships and one OHSAA Team Duals Regional championship along with compiling a 99-64 dual meet record.

Prior to serving as head coach at Upper Arlington, Stout served as a wrestling coach at the youth, middle school, and high school levels, including 12 years as the Director of the Upper Arlington Mat Cubs Youth Wrestling Program. In his role as Director of the Upper Arlington Mat Cubs, he was the primary founder of the 28 team Russ Hellickson Central Ohio Youth Wrestling League, which was created in 2011 and still exists today.

In his student-athlete days, Stout was an OHSAA state runner-up and four-time state qualifier for Upper Arlington from 1987-90 before

competing collegiately at the University of Michigan. A former walk-on, Stout earned a scholarship and was a team captain and three-year starter for the Wolverines from 1990-95.

Aside from coaching, Stout is a partner at the law firm of Bricker & Eckler LLP in Columbus where he specializes in public finance law. He provides school finance guidance to school districts, municipalities, and counties throughout Ohio and assists them in financing capital projects. In addition, Stout currently serves as the public address announcer for the University of Michigan Wrestling, a position he has held since 1995. He has announced two Big Ten Conference Wrestling Championships (2004 and 2010) and was the announcer for the Ohio Junior High State Wrestling Championships from 2003-2012.

2020 State Dual Team Championship Recap

COLUMBUS, Ohio – Divisions I and II came down to the final weight class while Division III saw a record-breaking margin of victory as Lakewood St. Edward (I), Louisville (II) and Milan Edison (III) took home championship trophies at the 2020 OHSAA Team Wrestling State Tournament at St. John Arena Sunday.

Lakewood St. Edward won its second-consecutive and fifth overall OHSAA Division I dual team wrestling championship in the tournament's eight-year history. Down 30-24 heading into the final two weight classes, the Eagles needed clutch performances from two seniors. Nickolas Lisco and Zachary Taylor delivered with pins in both the 220 and 285 pound weight classes to give St. Edward the 36-30 victory. On its way to the finals, St. Edward defeated Beavercreek 52-13 in the quarterfinals and Wadsworth 50-12 in the semifinals. The title ups the Eagles' total number of wrestling state championships in the team and individual tournaments to an OHSAA-record 38.

Like Division I, the Division II title came down to the final bout. Leading 31-30 entering the 285 pound matchup, Louisville senior Blake Robbins handed St. Paris Graham

Local its first loss in OHSAA Team Wrestling State Tournament history with a 3-1 sudden victory. Louisville's 34-30 win is the program's first team wrestling state championship. The Leopards defeated Hamilton Ross 69-6 in the quarterfinals and Bellevue 51-22 in the semifinals.

Milan Edison earned its second OHSAA team wrestling state championship in record-breaking fashion. Edison's 57-14 victory in the finals sets the record for most points in a finals match and largest margin of victory. The Chargers' path to the finals included a 66-3 win over Shenandoah in the quarterfinals and a 56-15 win over Brookville in the semifinals. Edison's previous team championship came in 2017.

Attendance was 4,015, an OHSAA Team Wrestling State Tournament record.
